The Jackson Hole Land Trust (JHLT) is a private, non-profit organization that was established in 1980 to preserve open space and the critical wildlife habitat, magnificent scenic vistas, and historic ranching heritage of Jackson Hole. In October 2016, we expanded our conservation service area in Western Wyoming by accepting a transfer of 58 easements totaling 32,000 acres from the Green River Valley Land Trust, now incorporated into our new Green River Valley Program. The purpose of the Green River Valley Program (GRVP) is to protect the future of Sublette County's open spaces, ranching lands and wildlife habitat.

**Position Description:** The "Ready for Workforce" student intern will participate in a job shadowing experience that will give them insight into land stewardship and community outreach. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:

**Stewardship**

- Accompany stewardship staff and assist in conducting annual conservation easement monitoring visits and field data collection
- Participate in Camp GROW presentations educating kids about conservation
- Interview a landowner to gather information for a web page spotlight
- Write short feature article about the landowner interviewed
- Research and write a stewardship focused newsletter story

**Outreach**

- Assist with the Pinedale Spring Expo on June 16<sup>th</sup>
- Assist with GRVP community picnic on June 23<sup>rd</sup> including:
  - ❖ Develop, organize, and implement an activity for children
  - ❖ Assist with other activities such as photography and information booth
- Assist with open house during the Green River Rendezvous, July 12-15
- Assist with the booth at the Wind River Mountain Festival, July 20-22
  - ❖ Operate a kid's activity center similar to picnic activity

**Qualifications**
